- 1. No Examinee shall be permitted to enter the examination hall without the printed Admit Card and a valid ID proof.
- 2. No materials or belongings other than Pen, Pencil, Admit Card and ID proof shall be allowed.
- 3. Possession of handwritten / printed material / electronic gadgets in any form is strictly prohibited for the examinee.
- 4. No examinee shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall after 10:15 AM.
- 5. The examinee shall not be permitted to answer the natural call during the examination.
- 6. The examinee shall not submit the answer sheet before the completion of the Examination.
- 7. Verbal or Non Verbal Communication between Examinees is strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall and any such activity shall amount to Unfair Means.
- 8. The Admit Card duly signed by the invigilator should be retained and produced by the candidate at the time of counselling.

 - i) Canvassing for the marks, personally or any other means.
 - j) Any other similar malpractice.
